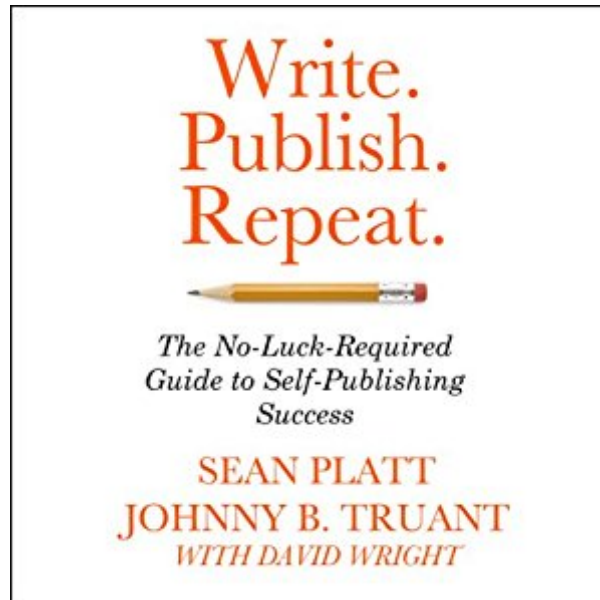

It's kind of like seeing somebody walk down the street, and noticing that his fly is open. He doesn't know why you're looking at him, and he may not know that he's embarrassing himself, but the fact is he left his fly open. He wasn't thinking when he put on his pants, or after he relieved himself. Either way, he's doing something he shouldn't be, and it draws your attention. Now imagine this person is presenting himself as an authority on fashion. This isn't just somebody you happened to see walking down the street, this is somebody is telling you that he knows how fashion works; that he's an expert on how to put together an outfit, and how to present yourself at your best. This is somebody who somehow managed not to notice that his fly was down, and it makes a difference. Tell me where your confidence level would be at this point. Sadly, that's the way I felt about this book. I went into it hoping that I was going to get some juicy tips and sage advice behind all of the productivity implied by the conversations I hear on the podcast these guys produce. I still listen to the podcast, and I enjoy it, but it's disappointing to see the actual writing their method produces. I guess I should have known when I look at the preview, and noticed that they were using the word I in the clause, "But even with only Sean and I writing," where they should have used me or, arguably, myself. It's not a really big thing. You have to be a grammar sticker these days even to worry about it. But still, these guys are passing themselves off as authoritative writers and publishers. They should take a stronger position than the lay reader on the correct use of language. Personally, I like watching the way language evolves.
